ORTA (Ohio Retirement for Teachers Association), MOF (Ohio STRS Members Only Forum) and the STRS Ohio Watchdogs formally announce the endorsement for Pat Davidson, Berea School District. THIS IS FOR AN ACTIVE TEACHER POSITION ON THE BOARD!

Three informed and reform minded candidates were interviewed including Rob Gilbert and Michelle Flanigan. In short, the interview committee was tasked with endorsing only one of three outstanding articulate candidates. The committee's focus was simple and direct.

STRS leadership has led active teachers down a path where they are paying more and working longer for less, while many retired teachers are facing financial hardships due to COLA loss. Trustees who continue to allow this to happen and resist change need to be replaced by individuals like Pat Davidson, Rob Gilbert, and Michelle Flanigan.

The STRS Board Election occurs in April and ends May 1st. More information on Pat Davidson and how to vote will be forthcoming.

#### I have three simple goals as your next STRS Board member:


- 1. Reduce the years of service to be eligible for retirement.

Please join ORTA in encouraging Treasurer Sprague to appoint a board member who will join the five existing pro-reform members to fight for transparency and accountability.



#### **ACRTA General Meeting**

December 1, 2022 11:30 Primrose Retirement Center

Secretary's Report: Melinda King: Filed as printed.

Treasurer's Report: Sue Cramer: We have a balance of \$7,218.83. We have \$825.69 in the teacher grant funds. The 2023 budget was presented and Mila Schwabero moved to accept the budget. William Peebles seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Filed for audit.

Membership: Norma Penn: We have 33 members for 2023.

ORTA: ORTA is working on membership growth and COLA. ORTA has launched a suit against STRS to reveal the investments of the STRS money. If we win the lawsuit for illegal investments, we can sue for back pay of lost COLA's. ORTA will begin screening candidates for the STRS active teacher representative election next spring. We need to influence the active teacher votes. We need one more board member who would be willing to change the way things are run at STRS.

Teacher Grants: We were able to award 13 grants between 14 teachers. We had an anonymous donation of \$2000 so we were able to award \$3177.46 this year. 89 grants have been given to date for a total of \$17,486.85.

Legislative: The legislative boundaries are still in dispute. The League of Women's Voters has filed a suit with the US Supreme Court.

Membership Health: Ross Bowers, Ed Hearne and Dave Lytle have passed away.

Old Business: Our book, *Memories from the Schoolhouse*, is available for sale. Please promote its sale. Thank you to Norma Penn, Mary Jordan, Lee Stockhaus, and Rose Phillips for decorating the Christmas tree at the Allen County Museum. Mila Schwabero moved to accept the up-dated by-laws. Ed Hoffmeyer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

New Business: Plaques were awarded to Secretary, Melinda King and President, Barb Hochstetler for their service for the last four years. Norma Penn was installed as president. Carol Baumgarte was installed as secretary. Cheryl Quay was also installed as vice-president due to not being able to be officially installed last year. Barb Hochstetler passed the engraved school bell to Norma Penn to begin her presidency for the chapter.

Raffle winner of the Christmas ornament and Encore tickets was Melinda King. The winner of a free meal was Ed Hoffmeyer. We raised \$95 for the teacher grants.

Next meeting Thursday, February 3, 2023, 11:30 at Elida Immanuel United Methodist Church. Meeting adjourned at 1:35.
